On 22 May the Home Office announced that those with visas already extended would automatically have them extended further, to the end of July. There is no need for this group of people to take any action. But those who have not already asked for an extension will need to make a request for the extension to apply to them. Government guidance states: If you're in the UK and your leave expires between 24 January 2020 and 31 July 2020 your visa will be extended to 31 July 2020 if you cannot leave the UK because of travel restrictions or self-isolation related to coronavirus. To get this extension, those affected must fill in an online form.
