Individual early intervention for vulnerable or at risk families

Stop It Now! Wales is a child sexual abuse prevention project run by The Lucy Faithfull Foundation, a child protection charity.

Since 2008, we've been working across Wales to make sure children and young people are protected from adverse childhood experiences by preventing child sexual abuse and exploitation. Stop It Now! Wales works in partnership with the Welsh Government to make children, young people and communities safer.

Working directly with families at risk

This programme provides educational intervention for a family identified by statutory or voluntary services as at risk, or as needing early intervention, with regard to child sexual abuse or exploitation (CSAE) but have not met the threshold for formal intervention or would benefit from educative intervention.

It results in families creating and implementing a family safety plan. We are encouraging multiagency partners to refer families to the project for us to work through a 'whole family' approach.

This will involve:

- Pre-meeting with the family and referrer to discuss the issues and ascertain the best way forward.
- Followed up by up to five individual education sessions with the family.
- Sessions will be arranged in partnership with the referral agency.

Examples to consider for referral are families where they have been concerns regarding:

- Inappropriate sexual behaviour of a child or a young person.
- Where a family member has been accessing indecent images of children.
- Families with children or young people who are considered at risk of child sexual exploitation.
- Ongoing concerns regarding family members who have a conviction for any sexual offences or where there are investigations for sexual abuse.

Please contact us to discuss if you need any guidance prior to referral.

We have received funding for a programme for families who have been identified as at risk, or as needing early intervention. This may be where sexual abuse has taken place or where allegations have been made or where other increased risk has been identified. They may also be families who have come to the attention of local services for other reasons.
